The Sanctuary Learning Centre at St Chad's is delighted to be offering its **NQT (Newly Qualified Teacher) Programme ©**. This programme, badged by **OLEVI** has been running successfully in Oldham for several years and is also being rolled out nationally by a number of Teaching Schools in conjunction with several Local Authorities.

This NQTP is designed to consolidate teaching pedagogy, develop personal reflection and improve teacher practice.

Based around the teacher standards, the programme breaks down all those aspects associated with effective classroom practice, develops understanding and moves teaching to a higher level. The programme includes a coaching element to support the Induction Tutor to ensure that the programme has maximum impact for all involved.

Aims:

- Understand concepts underpinning classroom practice and pedagogy.
- Support both NQT & Induction Tutor.
- Improve classroom leadership and practice for the benefit of all staff and learners.

Outcomes:

- NQTs will have a better understanding of a range of teaching pedagogy.
- Effective coaching/mentoring skills developed by the Induction Tutor.
- Clarity around roles and responsibilities for all involved.
- Maximum impact during the NQT year for all concerned.
