Where possible, the Sanctuary will endeavour to offer an alternative date to suit. Where programmes are run with multiple cohorts we will endeavour to transfer delegate's days, if in extreme and unforeseen circumstances, they are unable to attend a learning event. Learning programmes run over a number of sessions will have a minimum attendance level before delegates are considered successful. Cancellations received 10 working days or less before the course date will be charged 50% of the course fee.
